AVAILABILITY OF REPEATER,
TELEPHONE TA-287/GHeadquarters, Department of the Army, Washington, D. C.
8 February 1965

1. Purpose. This bulletin is published to notify using units that Repeater, Telephone TA-287/G is an expendable item in the supply system and has no TO/E or TA for basis of issue.

2. Information. Repeater, Telephone TA-287/G was procured as a replacement for EE-89 and TA-126/GT and is presently available for issue. The EE-89 was declared obsolete in June 1961 and TA-126/G was declared obsolete in September 1961.

3. Instruction. Review the item to determine whether it may be utilized in field wire line construction.

4. Procedure. Repeater, Telephone TA-287/G should be requisitioned through normal channels citing this supply bulletin as authority. It is a stock fund item and has a unit cost of \$20.40 each. Requisitions should cite funds and be submitted as soon as possible.
