LIMITED USAGE OF MAST AB-155/U WITH RADIO
BEACON SET AN/GRN-6 PENDING REDESIGN OF
MAST AB-360/G

1. Purpose. Mast AB-360/G is of fragile construction and has failed during emotion in a number of instances. It has been determined that Mast AB-155/U may be substituted for Mast AB-360/G without serious degradation in performance.

2. Information. Redesign of Mast AB-360/G has been initiated.

3. Instruction. This bulletin authorizes issue of three Masts AB-155/U for organizations utilizing Radio Beacon Set AN/GRN-6 in instances where frequent erection of antennae is required or where presently used Masts are considered hazardous by the using organization.

4. Procedure. Organizations authorized the use of Mast AB-155/U based on the criteria specified in paragraph 3 may submit requisitions citing this bulletin as the requisitioning authority. Mast AB-155/U, FSN 5820-251-2366, is stock fund item with a unit cost of \$155. However, due to the unsatisfactory performance of the AB-380/G, the AB-155/U will be issued on an initial replacement basis without charge to the customer. Requisitions submitted for the AB-155/U as an initial replacement of the AB-360/G Mast will cite Fund Analysis Code 60 in column 52 and 53 of DA Form 1348 or DA Form 1348M. Upon receipt of replacement Mast AB-155/U, the AB-360/G will be returned to the mission depot for modification. Requisitions for subsequent replacements of the AB-155/U require appropriate customer fund citation.

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
