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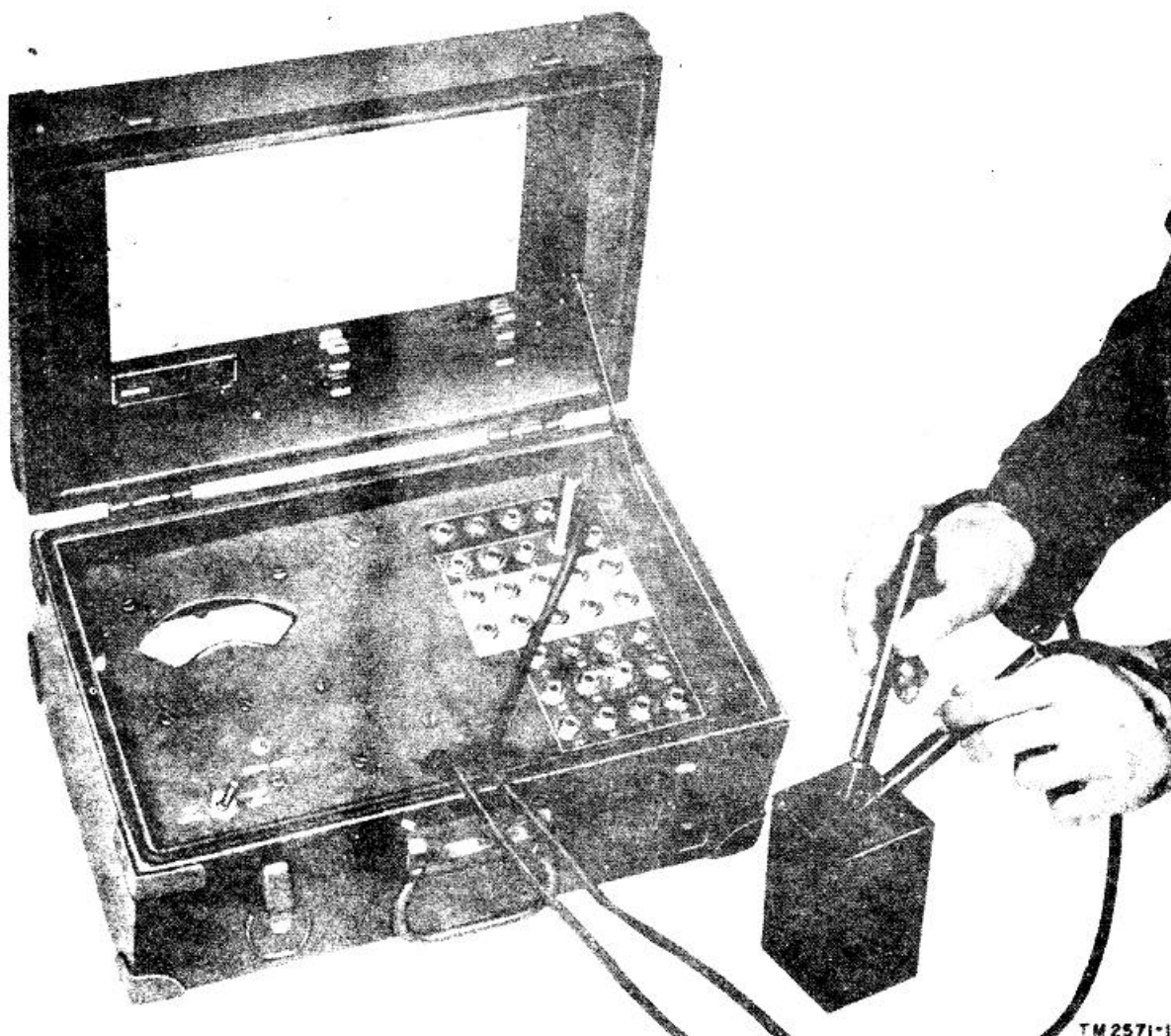


Figure 1-1. Battery Tester TS-183/U or TS-183 A/U.

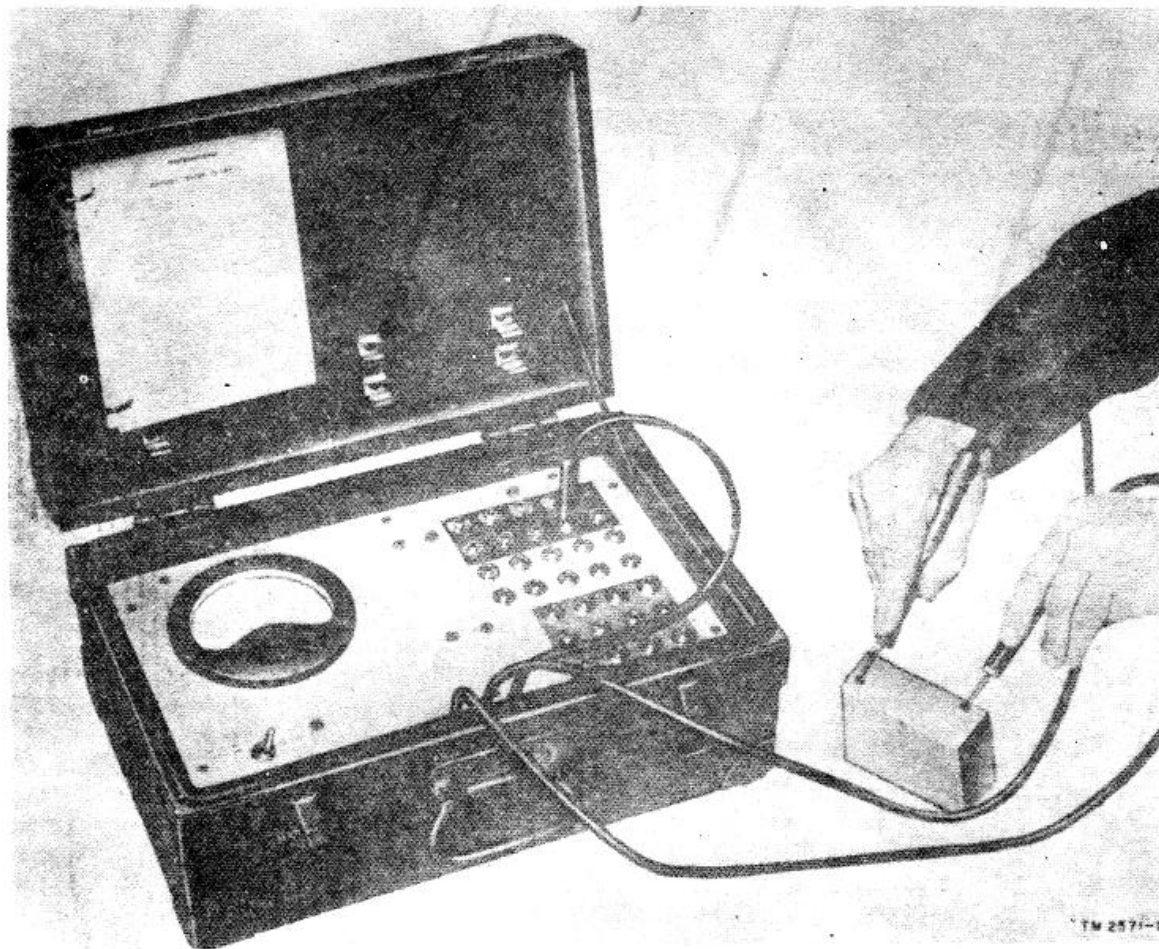


Figure 1-2 Battery Tester TS-183B/U
